
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Friends of Medha,

As we close out the academic year, and prepare for our biggest expansion yet, the last few months have been extremely busy here at Medha. We concluded the majority of our training in February and March, certifying 383 students across 11 colleges and polytechnics - an over 500% increase from this time last year, bringing our total alumni population to 440! 130 of these 383 students have already completed their internships, and the remaining students are scheduled to go over the summer break.

As we gear up to quadruple these numbers next year, we have spent a significant amount of time this quarter putting the systems and processes in place to manage this kind of growth, and are confident we can achieve our ambitious goal of 2500 students across 25 educational institutions in 2015 - 2016.

But while a lot of our focus over the last several months has been on increasing our outreach and achieving our targets, we wanted to share a poem written by one of our students that was a strong reminder to all of us about why we do what we do. Sometimes it's easy to get lost in the day-to-day challenges of work, trying to reach our professional and personal goals, and constantly thinking about 'what's next.'
