
# Building Personas Project Simmer

Meena spends most of her time with family and considers her father as a source of inspiration.


#### Routine 🦙

#### Her fears




Even though she enjoys her job, Rashmi is afraid that she might not get a promotion because her boss isn't aware of her great performance. She desperately hopes for a salary raise.

Skilled/networker/aware of career options/agency over career decisions


Arti is 18 years old and lives in Karnal, Haryana with her parents. She is currently pursuing Bachelor of Arts in a government-aided college.


Zoya doesn't have a personal smartphone. She sometimes uses her brother's laptop for surfing.




## Self-Image

#### The Working Group

- Most of our working alumni are either not getting or investing time to upskill themselves. This leads them to the struggles of availing a desired job profile or receive remuneration that is unsatisfactory.
- Their professional network is very limited because of which they lack guidance-role models or mentors who can support them in growing, finding suitable career opportunities and building overall self-confidence.
- Sectors and the presence of a team to work with has shown a significant difference in the motivation levels of working women.

#### The Non-Working Group

- Many of the non-working girls, could not articulate their real skills while describing themselves. This, again is due to lack of exposure, experiences and feedback in their current network.
- Career awareness across age groups and regions was considerably low. The were unable to identify different sectors, the skillset required and the actual profile needs. This is also leading to little career preparation at their end.
- Poor decision-making skills, as they look up to family members for direction in personal as well as career related situations.
